

Vision Online Services - Appointment Management, Repeat Prescriptions and Online Access to Summary Information.

Introducing Vision Online Services

St George's Surgery is introducing a new system for ordering repeat prescriptions, booking and cancelling appointments online and shortly Online Access to Summary Information.

If you have previously used our online services, you will need to re-register for the new Vision online services for appointments and repeat prescriptions by 28th February 2015, but please note that no other elements of our current online services will be affected by this change.

To start or continue to take advantage of the facility to manage your appointments and order your repeat medication online, you will need to register for our new service that is ready to access now.

Registering to the Vision Online Services

ATTENTION: EXISTING USERS TO CURRENT ONLINE SERVICES

If you are already registered to use the existing online services you will need to register for this service.

ATTENTION: NEW USERS TO ALL ONLINE SERVICES

New users can register for our online service by completing a **Pre-Registration Form** online below or alternatively by visiting the Surgery Reception and filling in the paper forms. Once you have completed and submitted this form to the Surgery, we will create your Vision Online account and you will need to call at the Surgery **with photographic identification (e.g. passport, driving licence etc.)** to receive a **Registration Letter** from the Practice.

Please be aware that, by allowing a spouse or other family member to use your password or shared email address you are enabling them to view appointments, medication and records which you may otherwise wish to keep confidential. For this reason we do not recommend the sharing of passwords and access ID information.

Passwords can be requested by parents on behalf of their children under the age of 12 but, in the interests of patient confidentiality, access will be ceased when the child reaches 12. New PIN numbers and Access IDs can be issued on an individual basis to patients over 12.
